NON-ATTENDANCE WILL COST YOU...

Did you know that as an OAG member, if you register for the Conference, and do not attend, your non-attendance costs the OAG approximately \$1,300 (hotel accommodation, breakfasts, lunches, dinners, nutrition breaks and administration.)? The OAG office is required to give guarantees to the venue at least seven (7) business days prior to the start of any Conference. Therefore, if you do not cancel by the seven-day prior deadline, you are included in the hotel room count and meal numbers for the entire Conference. It is the fiduciary duty of the Board of Directors to ensure that the OAG's monies are spent wisely.

The OAG has implemented a policy for Conference delegates – it is mandatory that you provide a valid credit card number to register for the Conference and specific events. Your credit card will not be charged unless you do not attend and neglect to notify the OAG office by the cancellation deadline (as indicated on the registration form - both online and in print.) The amount that will be charged to your credit card is the fee for one night's hotel accommodation, administration and your meals – approximately \$1,300.

If you need to cancel your hotel reservation, Conference or event registration, please refer to the registration form and contact the OAG office - you will receive a cancellation number as your validation.



THE ORG DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD

The Distinguished Service Award is given in recognition of a fellow gastroenterologist who has made an outstanding contribution in Gastroenterology.



DR. DAVID LYON WEINER-BARON, MD, FRCPC Join us as we honour, the incomparable, Dr. David Lyon Weiner-Baron with the OAG Distinguished Service Award.

Dr. David Baron is an Assistant Professor of Medicine at the University of Toronto. He is currently a staff gastroenterologist at North York General Hospital. He is a fellow of the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada. Dr. Baron holds memberships in the Ontario Association of Gastroenterology, Canadian Association of Gastroenterology and American Gastroenterology Association.

Dr. Baron is a former staff gastroenterologist and clinician teacher at Mount Sinai Hospital from 1990 until 2000. He was extensively involved in the education of medical students, internal medical residents, and gastroenterology Fellows. He served as the Medical Director of Endoscopy from 1997 until 2000. He was the President of the Medical Staff Association in 1996 and 1997. He had received several teaching awards while at Mount Sinai Hospital.

Dr. Baron has been a staff gastroenterologist at North York General Hospital since the year 2000. He was Chief of Medicine from 2000 until 2012, and vice chairman of the MAC from 2008 until 2012. He was Chief of Gastroenterology from 2012 until 2017. He is currently heavily involved in education of GI residents, surgical residents, and pediatric GI residents. He was the Course Director of the Update on Digestive Diseases from 1992 until 2012. He has served on the GI examination board for the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada since 2007.

Dr. Baron has been an integral part of the Ontario Association of Gastroenterology (OAG) since its inception and has served as the Association's President from 2009 until 2012. He has been on the OAG Board of Directors for over 20 years serving as its Secretary, Conference Chair, Treasurer and Vice President. He has also served as the GI Tarif Chair at the Ontario Medical Association from 1999-2007. He is a former GI Section Chair for the OMA from 2009 until 2016. Dr. Baron has been instrumental in the development of Quality Endoscopy in the province of Ontario and has served as the Central LHIN Endoscopy Lead from 2014 to 2023. He is a former Chair of the FIT Implementation Group for the Central LHIN and has been involved in numerous committees including the PBC Colonoscopy Quality Assurance Committee and Working Group. Dr. Baron has served on the Ontario Colonoscopy Expert Panel.

Dr. Baron is supported by his amazing wife Rachel. He is the proud father of Matthew and Zoe and father-in-law to Jon and Kelly.
